COVID 19 - PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION ACTIVITIES

COVID - 19 pandemic in the Indian state of Tamil Nadu was reported on 7 March 2020. The department of Health and Family Welfare has confirmed a total of 2,68,285 cases, including 4,349 deaths and 2,08,784 recoveries, as of 4 August 2020. Tamil Nadu lies third next to Maharashtra and Gujarat in No. of Corona positive cases. All 37 districts of the state are affected by the pandemic, with capital district Chennai being the worst affected. More than half of the cases are from Chennai, which is also the most populous district of the state. MMHRC has come forward to respond the Covid 19 virus in the following ways.

Amway opens telemedicine centre in Dindigul to benefit 20,000 villagers

Dindigul, June 1: Amway India, one of the country's largest direct selling FMCG companies, inaugurated its third rural telemedicine centre at Mettupatti village in Dindigul district in Tamil Nadu. The company has collaborated with Meenakshi Mission Hospital & Research Center to set-up and manage operations of the centre for providing free medical services to the local rural community with the help of telecommunication and information technology.

Commenting on the launch of the new telemedicine centre, GS Cheema, Senior Vice President – North and South, Amway India, said, "At Amway India, our endeavor is to make a tangible impact to the society through multiple social initiatives, in line with our vision of 'helping people live better, healthier lives'. CLEFT PALATE SURGERY

From Varanasi to Madurai with smiles to spread

SPREADING the message that cleft lip and cleft palate are treatable, the 'Smile Torch' that began its all-India journey in Varanasi in February, reached Madurai on Sunday and was received by Meenakshi Mission Hospital and Research Centre (MMHRC).

Smile Train India, a charity that facilitates free cleft palate surgeries, launched the 'Smile Torch', which travelled to 14 States. The organisation is about to complete its 20th year in 2020. Smile Train Senior Director of Programmes Leela Imam said that MMHRC has performed 12,700 cleft repair surgeries free of cost, since 2003. Many people, due to social stigma, are still not aware

that the condition is treatable by undergoing a surgery which would only take 45-90 minutes, she said.

Dr N Panchavarnam, Head of Department of Plastic Surgery, MMHRC, said several reasons, including consanguineous marriages and malnourishment during pregnancy, could cause the congenital deformity. "The condition can now be diagnosed as early as 12 weeks into pregnancy," Imam added.

The children who had undergone the surgery, along with their parents, gathered at MMHRC during the occasion and shared their experiences. R Sridevi, a resident of Subramaniyapuram, said her daughter is now into vocal music and had participated in many talent shows.

'Smile Torch' celebrates children born with clefts

Madurai: To create awareness and celebrate children born with clefts, 'Smile Torch' an event was organized by Smile Train, an international cleft care charitable organization at Madurai Meenakshi Mission Hospital and Research Centre (MMHRC) on Sunday.

As part of the 'Smile Torch' initiative, Smile Train India and partner hospitals organizes series of events to help sensitize communities across India about challenges faced by children born with clefts and support them. On Sunday, a talent show was organized at MMHRC where children participated and showcased their work in Madurai.

"The Smile Torch serves to remind communities that children with clefts have the right to smile and need our support. Only together, we can ensure complete integration of these children in ma-

instream society," said Leela Imam, program director, Smile Train India.

Chief guest of the event in Madurai, Commissioner of Police, Madurai city, Davidson Deshravatham S inaugurated the function and supported children born with clefts in his address.

"Children with untreated clefts often live a life of isolation. But, early intervention can help the child lead a normal life, get a good education and job and become a productive member of society," said Dr N Panchavarnam, cosmetic plastic and reconstructive surgeon at MMHRC.

In 19 years, Smile Train India has supported 6 lakh free cleft surgeries in India and over 34,500 free cleft surgeries in Tamil Nadu through a network of seven partner hospitals across various cities. The 'Smile Torch', which was launched on February 8 this year on National Cleft Day in Varanasi, will next travel to Chennai.

Call for awareness of free surgery for cleft lips and cleft palate

Awareness of readily available treatment and access to free cleft lip and cleft palate surgeries must be created among people in rural areas, said Leela Imam, Director-Programmes, Smile Train India.

Speaking to mediapersons here on Sunday at an event commemorating 20 years of Smile Train's service in India, she said, "Children with clefts are abandoned as it is unsightly. Women are of-

ten blamed for the child being born different. Our organisation attempts to change that perception by providing counselling to the mother and other family members and later performing the necessary surgeries," she said.

"Surgeries can even be performed when the child is three months old and weighs five kg. Smile Train India performs free surgeries to the children till they are 18 years old," she said.

Ms. Imam said 12,700 sur-

geries had been performed in Madurai through their partner - Meenakshi Mission Hospital and Research Centre since 2003. The hospital also offered speech training after the surgery, she added.

N. Panchavarnam, cosmetic plastic and reconstructive surgeon and Smile Train Project Director at the hospital, said cleft surgeries were common across the world. Earlier the defect was detected, earlier the surgery could be performed. "In other

private hospitals, the surgery costs about ₹1 lakh. Here, even our follow-ups and cross departmental consultations are free," he said.

B. Kannan, Medical Administrator, said nutritional deficiencies, lack of folic acid supplements, consumption of aspirin, drug abuse, environmental factors and radiation might have a bearing on whether a child was born with or without a cleft.

Commissioner of Police S. Davidson Devasiravatham was present at the function.

'There is still a stigma associated with cleft lip and palate condition'

Madurai: A wide smile lit up her face and eyes as the girl introduced herself with unabashed confidence, "Nean Sujitha. Sixth standard padikiren." Each word was pronounced perfectly till the last syllable. What would have been impossible is now possible for Sujitha V. one among the hundreds of children in India who were born with a cleft lip and palate.

Cleft lip and cleft palate are common birth defects. It is caused mostly due to genetic factors and nutrition deficiencies in pregnant mothers. The condition, though mostly non-fatal, can cause babies to have severe difficulty in breathing, feeding and speaking. It is estimated that in India, more than 35,000 babies are born with clefts every year.

"I was working as a daily wage labourer and my husband works at a mill. Sujitha, my third child, was born at Government Rajaji Hospital and immediately after birth we knew something was wrong with her. But we had no idea what to do or if we can

even afford treatment," said Jayachitra V. Sujitha's mother who resides in Vaniyapuram. Luckily, Sujitha became one of the nearly 12,000 children to get cleft surgery free of cost at Meenakshi Mission Hospital in Madurai, one of the partner hospitals of US-based charity organization Smile Train. The organization caters exclusively to children with cleft lip and palate.

"My daughter Harini is not facing any difficulty now after surgery. We were initially scared. Thankfully, people guided us here. Now my child is as bright as anyone else of her age," said Sakshi-N, another parent from Madurai city. Smile Train India is working with government agencies in the Department of Health and Department of Education to identify those with a

cleft condition in rural areas and create awareness. The corrective surgery which can cost up to ₹1 Lakh in a private hospital is done free of cost at Smile Train-sponsored hospitals.

"We try to bear all the expenses of poor families, even the travel cost to our partner hospitals. Often the child and parents stay there for up to one week for surgery and recovery getting the best care possible. We also offer counselling to mothers if needed," said Leela Imam, program director, Smile Train India.

The director further pointed out that a major challenge in India is that there is still a stigma associated with cleft lip and palate condition. "Often the mothers get blamed if their child is born with a cleft and have to face trauma which even affects their lactation. Some people are superstitious and blame it on karma instead of going for treatment. It is not something that affects the brain or is anything life-threatening. It just affects the face and is completely treatable," she said.

Mobile lab to improve access to testing

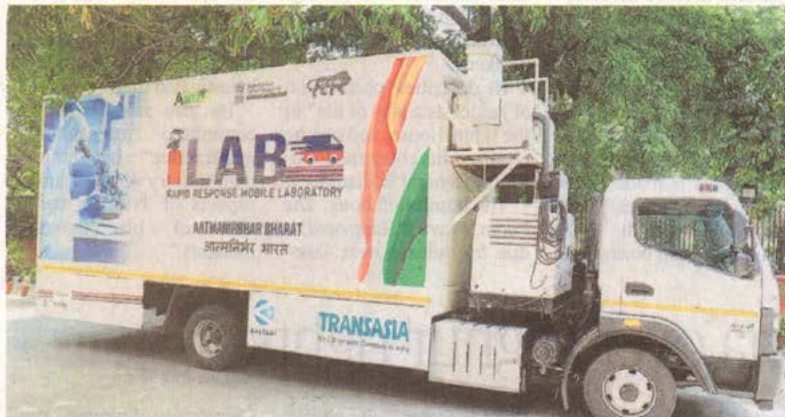
It can be deployed in remote areas: Health Minister

Union Health Minister Dr. Harsh Vardhan on Thursday launched the country's first mobile I-Lab (Infectious disease diagnostic lab) for last mile COVID-19 testing access.

The lab will be deployed in interior, inaccessible parts of the country and has the capability to perform 25 RT-PCR tests a day, 300 ELISA tests a day and additional tests for TB, HIV as per CGHS (Central Government Health Scheme) rates.

"Double set of machines can help increase the capacity to about 500 a day in 8 hours shift. It can be deployed in remote areas and

can be lifted from automotive chassis and put on goods train for sending to any location in the country," the Minister said.

The Infectious Disease Diagnostic Lab (I-LAB) is supported by the Department of

Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, under the COVID Command strategy, the Health Ministry said.

The number of government labs had now increased to 699 and private labs to 254

as of Thursday. "In the last 24 hours, 1,65,412 samples were tested. The total number of samples tested thus far is 62,49,668," it said.

The National Research Development Corporation (NRDC) has licensed the ma-

nufacturing know-how of a PPE (personal protective equipment) suit named - 'NavRakshak' - to five MSME clients to meet the ongoing country-wide demand for quality PPE kits.

PPE manufacturing

These five manufacturers put together are planning to mass produce more than 10 million PPEs a year, a Ministry release said.

The manufacturing know-how of NavRakshak was developed at the Innovation Cell of the Institute of Naval Medicine, INHS Asvini Hospital (Mumbai) of the Navy, from where the name was derived, it stated. "The PPE is cost-effective as it does not require major capital investment and can be adopted even by gown manufacturing units using basic stitching expertise," it added.

USAID to fund 200 ventilators for India

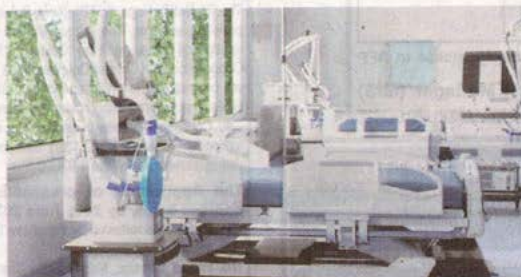
The devices will arrive in May and June, but the final delivery schedule will be notified next week

India will take delivery of 200 ventilators donated by the U.S. within the next month, government sources said on Monday.

The ventilators, which will be paid for by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), will arrive in May and June and the final delivery schedule notified next week, the sources said.

While the government has not commented on the value of the donation, it is likely to be funded by an additional grant of \$3 million that the

USAID made last month.

In a statement on April 16, the U.S. government said the funds through USAID would help "mitigate the spread of

COVID-19" and focus on financing healthcare access.

The ventilators, which were built for use in the U.S., are being "repurposed" for

donations to several countries, including India.

Modi thanks Trump

"India has been a great partner to us for quite some time, and I'm encouraged here about the ventilators to India. It's one of the several countries I noted that will be getting ventilators, because, you know, this President has done so well on ventilators - 100,000 [manufactured] in 100 days - that we are able to repurpose them and then send them around the world," White House Press Secretary Kayleigh McEnany said on Saturday.

Thanking Mr. Trump, Prime Minister Narendra Modi tweeted, "More power to the India-US friendship. In such times, it's always important for nations to work together and do as much as possible to make our world healthier and free from COVID-19."

According to the Health Ministry, India has 18,855 ventilators for COVID-19 patients at present, while the government's Empower group tasked with COVID-19 response said about 60,000 more had been ordered.

Assam NGO's 'smiley' offer tickles donors

A non-governmental organisation in western Assam's Barpeta has turned to humour to tackle the impact of the nationwide COVID-19 lockdown.

The initiative, says NGO Shubham, is for a cause – to collect funds to fight hunger – with donors getting a 'smiley profile' in return.

Members of the organisation got in touch with cartoonist Nituparna Rajbongshi to take forward the idea to gift each donor a caricature of their profile picture. And a few days go, the 'Your photo can bring a smile' campaign was born.

"Donors usually do not expect anything in return. But while encouraging people to donate for the needy and hungry people struggling to get essential commodities, we wanted to give each of them smile in return," Kuldeep Das, the NGO's secretary told *The Hindu*.

So the NGO's appeal came with a request for do-

"We have received 98 photographs so far in our initiative to provide food for the needy people around," said Mr. Das.

War veteran tops charts after record fund-raiser

Tom Moore's rendition of 'You'll Never Walk Alone' sold 82,000 units

A 99-year-old British Second World War veteran who shot to fame raising millions for health workers fighting the coronavirus has become the oldest artiste to reach No. 1 in the U.K. music charts.

Tom Moore's rendition of "You'll Never Walk Alone" – a much-loved and widely covered song from a 1945 musical – sold 82,000 units, the Press Association (PA) news agency said on Friday, beating Canadian artist The Weeknd's "Blinding Lights" in second place.

"It's out of this world, truly amazing!" Mr. Moore, a captain who served in India, said on his official Twitter account.

The single, which features Mr. Moore singing alongside actor and singer Michael Ball and a choir from the state-run health service is also the fastest-selling single of 2020 so far,

according to PA.

"My grandchildren can't believe I am a chart topper!" said Mr. Moore, who turns 100 at the end of this month.

Guinness World Records also announced that Mr. Moore has broken the record for raising the most money in an individual charity walk – more than £27 million. He set out to raise just £1,000 for the National Health Service (NHS) by walking 100 laps of his 25-metre (82-foot) garden.

What strategy did you adopt for the growth of Meenakshi Mission Hospital after you took over as Chairman from your father, Dr. N. Sethuraman, a reputed doctor himself?

Meenakshi Mission Hospital was established in 1985 by my father Dr. N. Sethuraman, a urologist, with 110 beds. He wanted to build a modern hospital in a small town like Madurai for the sole purpose of making healthcare affordable. I took charge of the hospital in 2005 when I was just 25. The hospital had grown to 250 beds by then. On taking over, I began to realign the company's management structure and focus on expansion. I brought in young people to run key departments.

Doctors were encouraged to give up consulting on the outside and work for the hospital full time. Today, more than 400 doctors are on the rolls of MMHRC. The

hospital has now grown to 1,000 beds and has become the biggest in South Tamil Nadu.

Can you tell us about some charitable programs run by Meenakshi Mission Hospital?

I believe the healthcare industry exists for the service of the people and its primary motive is healing. Being managed by S R Trust, a not-for-profitable institution, we have a vast charitable program and have incorporated CSR across all vital specialties. We have a dedicated ward for Pediatric Oncology, which has treated more than 2,000 child cancer patients for free. In alliance with Smile Train, we have performed over 13,000 cleft lip surgeries free of cost till now. A hospice centre inside the hospital provides palliative care to terminally ill patients. It is subsidized by 50 percent. Free meals are provided to all general ward patients, thrice a day, every day.

More than 10,000 plates of food are given away daily. We also organize health camps in remote villages through our Telemedicine vans with satellite link.

How is Meenakshi Mission Hospital contributing to healthcare needs of the region?

Indian healthcare is characterized by regional imbalances and rural-urban divide. Same is true for Tamil Nadu where healthcare facilities are unevenly distributed. With 1,000 beds, we are the largest super-specialty hospital in Tamil Nadu outside of Chennai, with a catchment area extending from Cuddalore and Karur to Kanyakumari. There are only a few hospitals in this area which can provide state-of-the-art healthcare facilities for the common people. For example, we are the only hospital in the region with the capability to conduct bone marrow transplants and have a highly advanced cardiology department.

Meenakshi Mission Hospital follows a unique model of acquiring world-class technology and offering it to the people at affordable rates. Its Robotic surgical facility, PET CT Scan, OCT scan for cardiac patients are good instances for this. The Hospital also offers comprehensive services for its patients like the Institute of Cancer Care, Institute of Gastro-intestinal surgeries, Institute of Joint replacement surgeries & Sports Medicine, Institute of Cardiac Sciences, Institute of Neuro Sciences, Institute of Fetal Medicine, Institute of Obstetrics & Gynecology. Our reputation for medical excellence and affordable costs is one reason why patients flock to our hospital not only from the surrounding districts, but also from across the country.

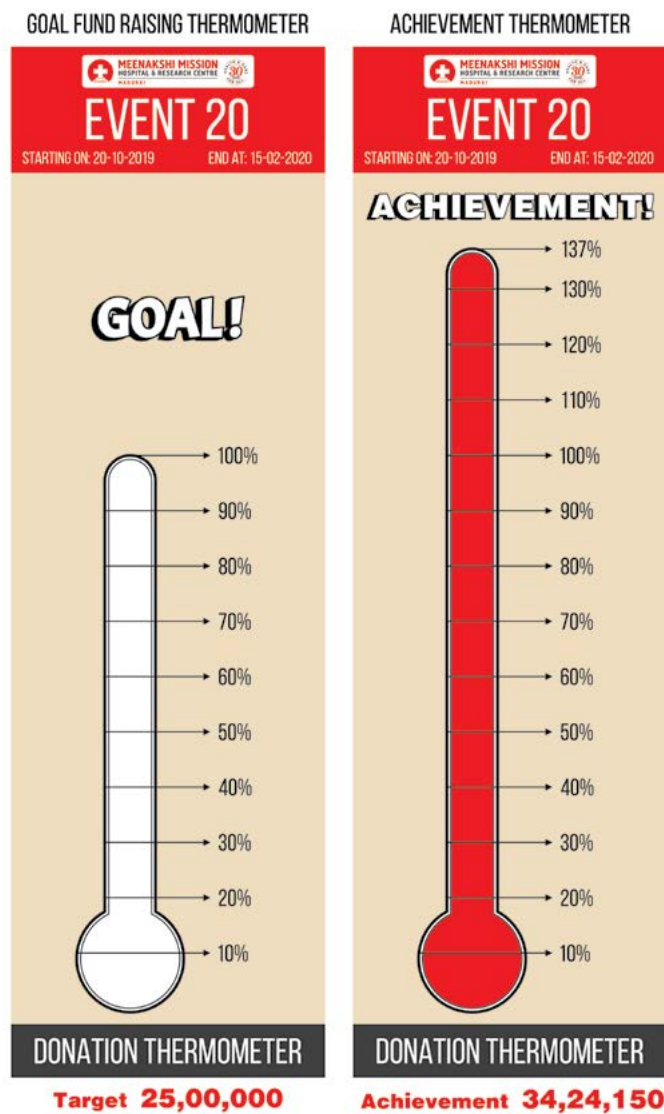

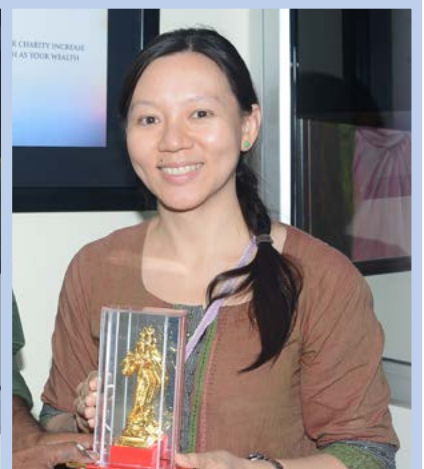
